eTwinning project

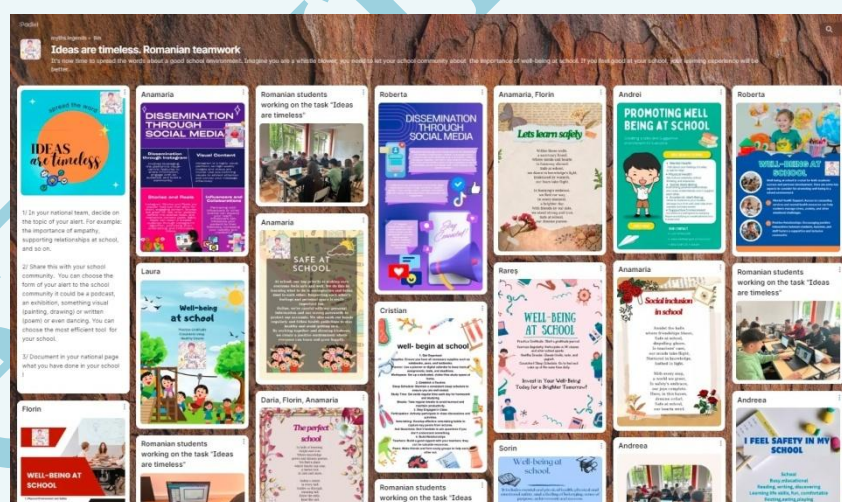
